A prize of \$500 will be awarded for the winning design! The winning design will be owned by the HPNA.

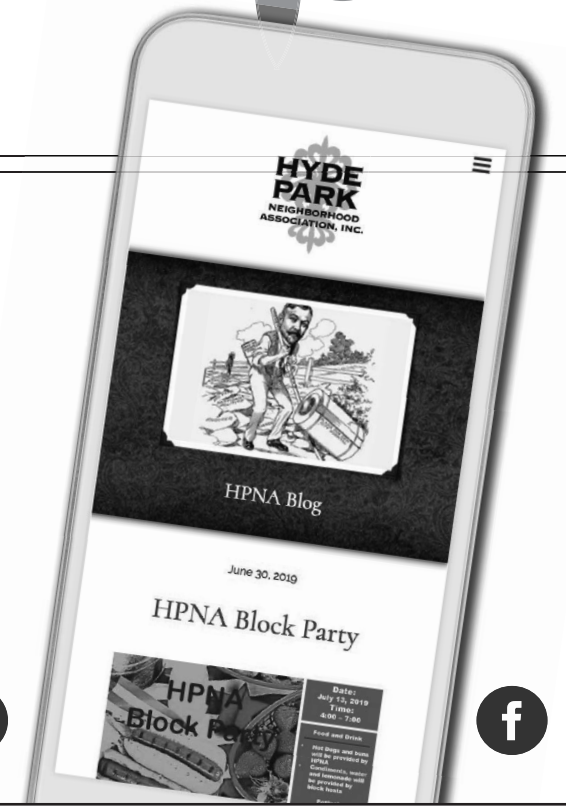
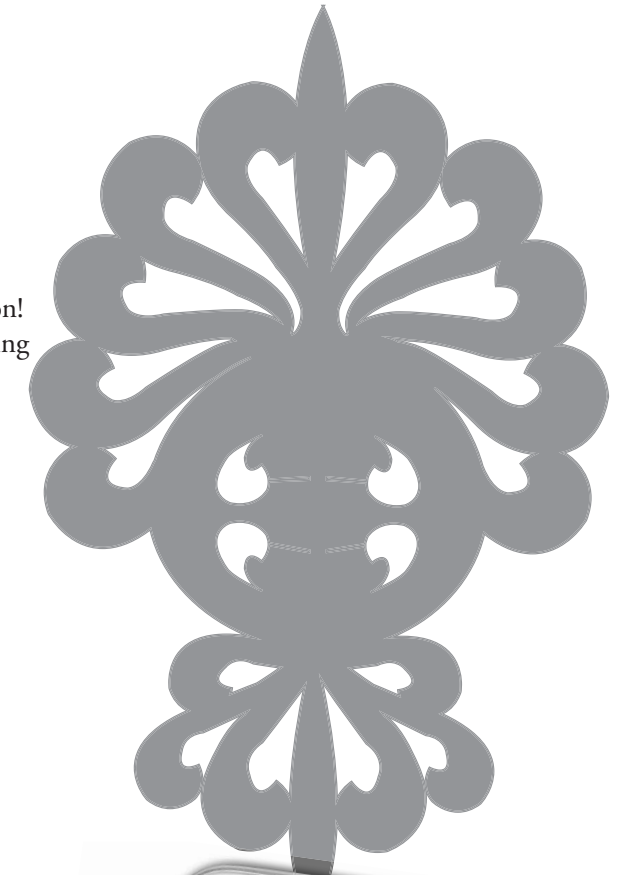
- Must clearly and prominently include "Hyde Park"
