Neighbors Urged to Comply with Stay-at-Home Order

The Hyde Park Neighborhood Association is organizing volunteers and working to provide the neighborhood with support and resources. The HPNA is seeking individuals from every block in the neighborhood to volunteer and serve as Block Captains who will be a point of contact for neighbors on their block. Area representatives from the HPNA Board will provide support to the Block Captains. Please visit hydeparkkc.org/coronavirus-covid-19 to sign up and get the latest information.

Neighbors are urged to comply with measures being take at the city, state, and federal level to prevent and slow the spread of COVID-19. Mayor Quinton Lucas has issued a stay-at-home order that began March 24 and will last through April 24. The order directs all residents to stay home except for essential needs and directs non-essential businesses and operations to cease. Essential activities include the following:

- Tasks essential to a person's health and safety, or to the health and safety of their family and close personal acquaintances (including medical visits, obtaining medicine or supplies needed to work from home)
- Obtaining necessary services or supplies (including food and household supplies)
- Delivering necessary services or supplies to others
- Engaging in outdoor activities while complying with social distancing
- Performing work providing essential products and services
- Care for a family member, close acquaintance or pet in another household

The 2020 Hyde Park Homes Tour will be rescheduled for 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Kansas City areas schools will remain closed during this time. Daycares and early childhood programs are exempt from this order. Trash and recycling pick-up will not be affected. To read the complete order and other updates, visit kcmo.gov/coronavirus.

The Missouri Department of Revenue also announced an extension of the state tax filing and collection deadline to July 15, and any driver licenses or vehicle registrations set to expire during the order will have their dates extended an additional 60 days. Safety recommendations surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic are updated frequently. Neighbors are encouraged to read, watch, or listen to local newspapers, tv and radio stations to stay up to date with the latest changes.

The Kansas City Public Library provides free e-books and downloadable audiobooks for library card holders through Overdrive at kclibrary.overdrive.com or through the mobile app called Libby. Books for adults, teens, and children are available. Anyone needing a card who is 13 or over can sign up online to gain immediate access to their digital collections, which include books, audiobooks, magazines, videos, comics, and music.
